Dalmatia – North Dalmatia Nature Park by Bike and Boat 2018
Individual Self-Guided Tour
8 days / 7 nights

Violet sage, deep green pine forests and the blue of the Adriatic: these colours dominate in the coastal regions in the North of Dalmatia. Discover the small, hidden bays and idyllic fishing villages on this tour. Dive into the glass clear water and relax on the sundeck. By bike you cycle through scented forests and frequently have the wide expanse of the sea and numerous islands in your view. You'll be cycling mostly along paved paths, which when outside of the peak holiday season, are quiet. The route includes some more intense inclines. A certain level of basic fitness is required; if you like you can spend half or whole days on board, swimming, relaxing and sunbathing.

Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: Individual arrival in Zadar, Zadar - Vir 30 km

Embarkation between 11:30am and 1pm in Zadar. You are welcomed on board by the tour guide with drinks and a snack. Your first trip is in the afternoon. It takes you through Kožino, Petrčane and Zaton and over a bridge to Vir on the island of the same name.

Day 2: Vir - Molat Island - Zverinac Island 20 km

In the morning, relax on the boat as it takes you to the island of Molat. In Molat, you get back on your bike and cycle to Zapuntel and back. In the afternoon you sail by boat to the island of Zverinac.



Day 3: Zverinac island - Dugi Otok island - Rava island 30 km

In the morning, relax on the boat as it takes you to the island of Molat. In Molat, you get back on your bike and cycle to Zapuntel and back. In the afternoon you sail by boat to the island of Zverinac.



Day 4: Rava Island - Dugi Otok Island - Kornati Islands – Šibenik 20 km

Today begins with a boat trip, destination being Sali on the island of Dugi Otok. Next, you cycle to Telašćica Nature Park and then back to Sali. The boat takes course for the Kornati Islands National Park and after about 4 to 5 hours you reach Šibenik.

Day 5: Šibenik - Krka National Park - Vodice 20 km

First, the boat takes you along Krka River to Skradin. Today, the short cycle tour begins to the famous Krka waterfalls. The river falls over a distance of 800 m through 17 waterfalls down 46 m into the deep. Back in Skradin you go on board and leave for the harbour of Martinska. From there, you cycle to the place where you stay the night – Vodice.

Day 6: Vodice - Murter Island 35 km

The day begins with a great cycle tour! You'll get to know a section of the coast first, with lots of pretty islands. You soon reach a viewing point, known as "Okit". Via Tribunj and Sovlje you continue on to Tisno. Crossing a bridge you cycle on to the island of Murter and from there via Lovišća, Plitka Vala, Betina and Murter to the bay of Podvrške.

Day 7: Murter Island - Pašman Island - Ugljan Island - Zadar 30 km

As you breakfast on board, you are taken to Tkon on the island of Pašman. Here you hop on to your bike and cycle from Tkon via Pašman, Neviđane, Dobropoljana and Ždrelac to the bridge that connects the two islands of Pašman and Ugljan. You continue on via Kali to Preko. In the afternoon the boat takes you back to Zadar. On the way back you stop for a last dip in the sea.

Day 8: Individual departure

Disembarkation is after breakfast until 9 am. Then you set off on your individual journey home or get your transfer to the airport

Technical Characteristics:

Tour Profile: Easy. The route mostly follows paved roads which are quiet if you avoid the holidays. The route does involve several relatively steep inclines. You should have a sound level of fitness. If you wish you can spend half or whole days on the ship and go swimming instead of cycling.

MS Dalmatino



The motor yacht Dalmatino was built in 1957 and reconstructed in 1990. You can look forward to the air-conditioned saloon and a large sun deck of about 90 m² with 10 deck chairs. On deck you'll find tables with benches for about 20 people. 8 double cabins with bunk beds are on the main deck, 5 on the upper deck. The cabins do have portholes that can be opened.

MS Carpe Diem



The MS Carpe Diem was built in 2015/2016 and first set sail in spring 2016. On the boat is an air-conditioned saloon, a sun deck of about 250 m² with 20 deck chairs, tables, benches and chairs on the roofed upper deck. There is a bathing platform with showers at the stern. There is a bike garage on the main deck. There is 1 three bed cabin with French bed and separate single bed, 11 double cabins with French bed, 5 double cabins with single beds and 1 single cabin.
