Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: Arrival in Strasbourg

Arrival in Strasbourg, check into the hotels and free sightseeing in the city.

Day 2: Strasbourg – Obernai 37 km

Ride along the cycle path beside the Canal de la Bruche from Strasbourg to Molsheim. Continue via Rosheim, with its wonderful 12th century Romanesque church, to Obernai.

Day 3: Obernai – Saverne 44 km

On the third day, you ride through the Vosges along the Wine Route to Marmoutier, where you will see one of the most beautiful Romanesque facades of Ottonian architecture in Europe. You continue to Saverne, the pretty capital of the Northern Vosges.

Day 4: Saverne – Ingwiller 48 km

You are in the Northern Vosges Regional Natural Park, where you will be amazed by the churches of St-Jean-les-Saverne and Neuwiller. You continue to Lichtenberg with its castle and former residence of the Counts of Hanau-Lichtenberg. Finally, you get to Ingwiller.

Day 5: Ingwiller – Haguenau 30 km

Passing through the small streets and ornate rural villages of the Hanau region, you come to the cycle path running through the Heiligenwald to Haguenau.

Day 6: Haguenau – Strasbourg 40 km

In its time, Haguenau was the hops capital, and the surrounding villages are still former hops villages with typical large farms. The end of the tour brings you along the canal into the European district of Strasbourg.

These bikes are supported by an electric motor. The motor is attached to the bottom bracket. The energy supply for the electro engine is retained via a detachable battery, with a possible range of 120 to 180 kilometers. The electro bike is a Pedelec which is an electro bike which assists with electric support only when pedaling. Designed and based on KTM-bikes and modified accordingly for our purposes. The bikes are easy to handle as you have an improved weight distribution and a lower center of gravity. Total weight amounts to approx. 23 kg. An illuminated LCD display, a bike computer and a wattage display - all these features make these bikes very user friendly.

28 inch wheels and three different support modes provide and guarantee maximum cycling bliss. All accessories are identical to the list above
