

Croatia – Bike and Boat in South Dalmatia (2025) Individual Self-Guided Cycling Tour 8 days / 7 nights



The view from the sun deck of the deep blue, crystal clear Mediterranean Sea. Shore densely overgrown with holm oaks and pines - your ship will take you from island to island: that's island hopping in southern Dalmatia. Croatia is the purest vacation paradise and this is of course also true for the south of the country. On the way, you will discover secluded bays that are made for diving into the Mediterranean Sea directly from your ship. On the bike, you will explore the winding paths of the south Dalmatian coast with your guide. You'll be cooked delicious regional dishes and spend evenings under the open sky lit by countless stars. Island hopping in South Dalmatia is the ideal combination of cycling and swimming cruise in the warm Mediterranean Sea.



You can book the trip in South Dalmatia in three different categories:

In the Comfort category you will travel on the motor sailer Aneta. More comfort you will find in the premium category on the motor sailers Amore and Azimut. If you want to treat yourself to a higher category, the Deluxe motor yachts Relax and Mystic are the right ships for you.

Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: Individual arrival in Trogir, Trogir – Brač island (boat), Bike tour Brač island, approx. 25 km / 380 altitude difference

You go on board between 12:00 and 14:00 in Trogir. At a "Welcome-Aboard" drink hosted by your tour guide, you are invited to a small snack before setting off during the afternoon to the island of Brač.

There, you will go off on a small bike tour from Supetar to Pučišća.

Day 2: Brač island – Korčula island (boat), bike tour Korčula island approx. 30 km / 540 altitude difference Right after breakfast, the boat casts off for the island of Korčula. It is known as the black island because of the pinewoods here. From the harbour in Račišće you cycle via Kneža and Žrnovska Banja to Korčula. Via Pupnat and Kneža you will return to the ship to Račišće. By boat you will go to the town of Korčula.



Day 3: Korčula island – Mljet island (boat), bike tour Mljet island, approx. 30 km / 700 altitude difference.

Mljet island – Elaphiti islands (boat) Enjoy your morning on board the boat as you sail over to the island of Mljet. From Sobra, you cycle through the island's forests via Prožura to Saplunara. After lunch and a break for a swim you cycle back to Sobra. From there you set sail again. Target today is: the Elafiti island of Šipan.

Day 4: Bike tour Šipan island, approx. 10 km / 110 altitude difference,

Šipan island – Dubrovnik (boat) Today starts with a short cycle over the island of Šipan, from Šipanska Luka to Suđurađ and back. On board your boat, you sail to Dubrovnik, arriving around lunchtime. After lunch on board, you can go on a guided tour of the town. After the tour there is plenty of time to get to know the UNESCO World Heritage town.



Day 5 Dubrovnik - Pelješac peninsula (boat), round trip from Pelješac, ca. 25 km / 270 m

In the morning you will take the boat to Kućište. You will get on your bike and ride via Viganj to the viewpoint at 173 m above sea level. Afterwards, you will ride along the "upper road" to Orebic and after a coffee break back to Pelješac. Here the captains dinner is waiting for you.



Day 6: Pelješac peninsula – Hvar island (boat), bike tour Hvar island, approx. 40 km / 600 altitude difference

First the boat takes you to Hvar. From here, you cycle through fields of lavender and vineyards to Stari Grad, the oldest settlement on the island. In Stari Grad, lunch is served on board, then you set off for the second part of your cycle tour, a circular tour via Vrboska and Jelsa. You stay the night in the harbour at Stari Grad.

Day 7: Hvar island – Insel Šolta (boat), bike tour Šolta

island, approx. 20 km / 200 altitude difference, Šolta island – Trogir (boat) During the two-hour boat trip from Stari Grad to Stomorska on the island of Šolta simply enjoy the beautiful countryside passing by. You cycle from Stomorska to Maslinica through lovely unspoiled villages. After lunch and a last swim, the boat takes yo back to Trogir.

Day 8: Individual departure

Disembarkation is after breakfast until 09.00. Then you set off on your individual journey home or get your transfer to the airport.

Technical Characteristics:

Tour Profile: Average. You'll be cycling mostly along paved paths, which when outside of the peak holiday season, are quiet. The route includes some more intense inclines. A certain level of basic fitness is required; if you like you can spend half or whole days on board, swimming, relaxing and sunbathing. **Distance:** 195 km

MS Aneta Standard



The MS Aneta was built in 1958 and completely renovated in 2009. The ship offers a saloon, a 150 m² sun deck with 15 deck chairs for relaxing, as well as tables and chairs for 20 people. The lower deck houses 2 three bed cabins with a double bed and a single bunk bed above. The main deck (above deck) offers 13 double cabins with bunk beds. Some of the windows in the cabins can be opened.





MS Amore, premium category

The MS Amore was built in 2011. The comfortable motor sailing boat offers an air-conditioned saloon, a 250 m² sun deck with 25 sun loungers and 20 deck chairs, tables and benches on deck for approx. 20 people, and a bathing platform with showers at the rear of the boat. On the lower deck there are 4 double cabins with twin beds, 2 double cabins with French bed and 2 triple cabins with French bed and single bed next to it. The main deck is divided into the middle deck and the upper deck above. On the middle deck there are 4 double cabins with twin beds, 1 double cabin with French bed and on the upper deck 4 double cabins with twin beds, 2 double cabins with French bed. The cabin distribution is done on site. The windows (in the cabin door) in the cabins on the main deck can't be opened. The cabins on the lower deck have portholes that can be opened.

MS Azimut, premium category

The motor sailer Azimut was built in 2016. In the years 2019 - 2022, the ship was renovated in several steps. Among other things, the bathrooms and salon were renovated, new air conditioning was installed and a bathing platform was built at the stern. You can enjoy a large sun deck of approx. 90 m² with sunbeds and seating. On the stern area of the upper deck there are more sun loungers, tables and chairs and even a whirlpool. The air-conditioned saloon seats 40 people. There is further seating on the main deck. On the lower deck there are 6 double cabins with French bed, 2 triple cabins with French bed and single bed above. On the main deck there are 3 double cabins with single beds, 1 double cabin with French bed and 2 triple cabins with French bed and single bed above.



MY Mystic, deluxe category

The motor yacht Mystic was built in 2015 and, like her sister ship MY Relax, belongs to the Ercegović family. There is an air-conditioned salon, a sun deck of approx. 220 m² with 40 sun loungers and a bathing platform with showers at the rear of the ship. In the lounge area on the covered upper deck behind the saloon there are comfortable seating groups for about 20 people, which can be closed with tarpaulins depending on the weather. On the lower deck there are 4 double cabins with twin beds, 2 double cabins with French bed and 2 triple cabins with French bed and single bed next to it. The main deck has 9 double cabins with twin beds and 2 double cabins with French bed. The cabins on the lower deck have portholes that can't be opened. The windows in the cabins on the main deck can be opened.
