

Czech – Austria – Prague- Cesky Krumlov to Vienna Bicycle Tour (2025) Guided or Individual Self-guided 8 days / 7 nights



For the first part of the trail from Prague to Cesky Krumlov, you will travel by minibus or car. We leave Prague early in the morning in order to have sufficient time to explore the best-preserved medieval town in Europe, Cesky Krumlov. If you cannot wait to get on the bike you can cycle 26 km long round trip up to Klet hill from Cesky Krumlov on the first day. During the following days, we will travel through the lands of the Trebon ponds and through the woods on the border with Austria called Czech Canada. You will visit the Renaissance towns of Trebon and Telc and many others. The trail will take you through the vineyards of South Moravia, where you will lodge in the cultural centers of the region, Znojmo and Mikulov. The whole trip ends in Vienna. The programme for the tour consists of a ride from Prague to Vienna and ends with a night in Vienna. As the tour does not include accommodation in Prague before the tour, we recommend that you purchase two or three extra nights in Prague before the beginning of the tour. That way you will have enough time to overcome jetlag and explore Prague. Some extra nights in Vienna will give you enough time to relax after six demanding days of biking.

The tour from Prague to Vienna combines biking and minibus transfers so that you can visit all the famous historical sites along the way and have a pleasant ride through the beautiful landscapes of Southern Bohemia and Moravia.

Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: Prague – Cesky Krumlov 175 km by minibus or car

Transfer from Prague to Český Krumlov, free time, sightseeing in Český Krumlov. Welcome briefing and dinner at restaurant (Guided Group Tours only).



Day 2: Cesky Krumlov - Trebon 55 km

The first cycling day leads through the beautiful hilly landscape surrounding Český Krumlov. However, the closer you get to Třeboň area, the flatter the landscape becomes. A scenic ride through a picturesque landscape ends in Renaissance town of Třeboň, well-known as a major spa resort. In park near Třeboň you can visit the Schwarzenberg Tomb.



Day 3: Trebon - Telc 78 km

Optional tour of Trebon chateau in the morning. The trail winds along many ponds and man-made lakes, so typical of this region, to Perslak, the most northern point of Austria. You will follow the border with Austria on the Greenways trail passing through Nova Bystrice. From Nova Bystrice the trail will take you through the forests of the National Park called Czech Canada. The day ends in Telc, a Renaissance town registered on the UNESCO Cultural Heritage List. Houses on the main square in Telc, with facades decorated with typically Renaissance graffiti, form the bestpreserved Renaissance Square in the Czech Republic.

Day 4: Telc - Vranov 55 km

Optional tour of Telc chateau in the morning. You will ride through several charming villages typical for this area of the country. We will cycle gently through the region of South Moravia. We will stay overnight in Vranov which is situated near a dam.



Day 5: Vranov - Znojmo 32-38 km bike

You will cycle on the Greenways trail following the river Dyje and the southern Czech border with Austria. You can choose between faster paved route and a longer and more demanding but very beautiful trail through the national park of Dyje. Znojmo is the gateway to South Moravia – the region of wine production.

Day 6: Znojmo - Mikulov 61-72 km

This flatland region is a traditional grape growing area and there are many wine cellars. We continue and arrive to Mikulov, a town with a rich history, a beautiful castle and a historical square. You can choose between the shorter and longer option. Exploring Mikulov on your own in the evening.





Day 7: Mikulov - Vienna 46 km and transfer to Vienna 50 km by car

You cross the border at the Mikulov border checkpoint, and spend the rest of the day in Austria. The ride in Austria is, to begin, very similar to the Czech section. There are vineyards, fields and small villages along the trail. The cycling part of the tour ends in Mistelbach (45 km) where you meet the driver who takes you directly to your hotel in Vienna. You can also meet the driver in Poysdorf (25 km). This has to be agreed in advance. The official tour programme ends with a check-in to your Vienna hotel.

Important notice: For guided group tours the support vehicle with bikes and the tour leader leaves Vienna on Day 7 in the early afternoon. You can return by supporting vehicle to Prague for free and spend the last night in Prague.

Day 8: Individual Departure

The tour ends with a breakfast either in Vienna or in Prague.

Technical Characteristics:

Tour Profile: Average. To the main recommended route are added easier and longer/harder alternatives. These routes combine roads without traffic, paved path as well some short off-road sections. Profile includes all from long flat section to some rolling hills. This route does not have a long steep up hills.

Distance: 325 -360 km
