


France - Fortified Castle Trail Northern Vosges Mountains Hiking Tour (2025) Individual Self-Guided 8 days/7 nights



Alsace is a land of castles. From the north to the south of the Vosges Massif, a hundred stone sentinels watch over the plain. So many witnesses of a thousand-year-old history that we suggest you discover thanks to our hiking trips. This escapade in the Vosges du Nord Regional Nature Park, classified as a World Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO, will give you a range of new sensations. At the bend of shaded paths, you will discover ancient churches, castles, military remains of the Maginot Line, sandstone peaks covered with magnificent forests of fir, beech or pine, and charming little villages, with their crystal artisans or stonecutters. It is in this harmonious landscape that the spire of the Strasbourg cathedral can be seen in the distance

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Wissembourg

Arrival in Wissembourg, settling into the hotel and tour of the old town and museum.




Day 2: Wissembourg – Lembach 23 km + 749 m – 714 m

Departure via the Col du Pigeonnier towards the Pfaffenschlick and the Soultzerkopf. Arrival in Lembach where the Four à Chaux, a former fortress of the Maginot Line, is situated.

Day 3: Lembach – Obersteinbach 18 km + 621 m - 571 m

You will discover the castles of Loewenstein and Hohenbourg in the morning. In the afternoon you can visit the castle of Fleckenstein which was formerly one of the most imposing in the Vosges, and later castle of Froensbourg.



Day 5: Niederbronn-les-Bains – Ingwiller 21 km + 733 m - 729 m Castle of Wasenbourg which overlooks the Niederbronn valley followed by the romantic remains of the Grand Arnsbourg. Your route of this day goes through beautiful Alsatian villages Oberbronn, Offwiller, Rothbach to Ingwiller.



Day 6: Ingwiller – La Petite Pierre 19 km + 589 m - 423 m From the valley of the Moder you go to Sparsbach and to the Englischberg then you will arrive in attractive village of La Petite Pierre perched on her headland of pink stoneware.

Day 7: La Petite Pierre – Saverne 21 km (+555m/-687m)

You will soon reach the "Rocher du Corbeau". Then, you will descend towards the village of Graufthal,known for its unique troglodyte houses carved into the rock. It offers authentic charm and a rich medievalhistory. Finally, before arriving in Saverne, the pretty capital of the Northern Vosges

Day 8: End of the trip after breakfast
