Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: Arrival in Strasbourg

Arrival in Strasbourg, settling into the hotel and free time to explore the town.

Day 2: Strasbourg – Sélestat Area 25 or 55 0r 65 km

You will leave Strasbourg following the Rhone to Rhine canal to reach Osthouse, Saint-Hippolyte or Sélestat, a city rich in a remarkable ancient architectural heritage



Day 3: Sélestat Area - Colmar 60, 65 or 50 km

After visiting the beautiful baroque abbey of Ebersmunster, you will cross the traditional villages of the Ried. This areabordered by the III and the Rhine is crisscrossed by multiple waterways where a rich fauna and flora flourish. After following the canal, you will arrive in Colmar, a city of art with an exceptionally well-preserved historical center



Day 4: Colmar – Guebwiller 35 or 45 km

Take advantage of this short stage to deepen your visit of Colmar in the morning. Do not miss the opportunity to contemplate the Issenheim Altarpiece, a masterpiece of the Rhenish Renaissance preserved in the chapel of the Unterlinden Museum, which houses many other treasures. You will then drive to Westhalten or Guebwiller, a wine-producing village located at the foot of the Grand Ballon Kaysersberg and Riquewihr.

Day 5: Guebwiller area - Riquewihr area ≈ 50 or 40 km

You will take theRoute des Vins, a mythical itinerary with exceptional landscapes and wine cities animatedby passionate winegrowers. At the foot of the Vosges Mountains, it will make you discover charming villagesthat make the fame of the Alsatian great wines: Eguisheim, Turckheim, Kaysersberg and Riquewihr

Day 6: Riquewihr area - Obernai area ≈ 35 or 50 km

Still along the Wine Route, you will discover the villages of Hunawihr, Ribeauvillé, Bergheim, Andlau and its Roman abbey, before arriving at your hotel. Each of these villages offers numerous possibilities for visits dedicated to biodiversity, culture and local folk arts and traditions. You will be staying either in Andlau or Obernai.

Day 7: Obernai area - Strasbourg ≈ 55 or 40 kmIn Rosheim,

you will discover the Saints-Pierre-et-Paul church, one of the jewels of Alsatian Roman architecture. In Molsheim, you will join the bicycle path of the Bruche canal that will lead you to the heart of Strasbourg. The reunion with the European capital, its art of living and its gastronomy, will conclude your stay in beauty .Departure or extension of the stay
