

Germany - Berlin Wall Cycle Route (2025) Individual Self-Guided 6 days / 5 nights



Following the traces of the former Berlin Wall, this cycle tour offers fascinating impressions. Always following the former Wall, you cycle on at the Brandenburg Gate to Checkpoint Charlie and then to Kreuzberg. From here south to Neukölln to Sonnenallee. Along the Havel via Babelsberg you will reach Potsdam and then follow the northern course to Oranienburg.



Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: Berlin/Oranienburg

Travelers are responsible for their own transportation to Oranienburg. There is a direct S-Bahn

connection to Berlin Mitte. Rental bicycles which have been booked in advance will be waiting at your destination hotel when you arrive. Overnight stay in Oranienburg.

Day 2: Oranienburg - Berlin Mitte: 44 km Through the Tegeler Fließ nature reserve, you follow the course of the Wall along the Reinickendorf city border to Pankow to Wedding. The tour continues to the former border crossing at Invalidenstraße. On the



Kronprinzenbrücke bridge, the route leads across the Spree to the Reichstag and the Brandenburg Gate. Overnight stay in Berlin-Mitte.



Day 3: Berlin Mitte – Teltow: app. 59 km At the Brandenburg Gate, the route follows the former course of the Wall to Potsdamer Platz and on to the former Checkpoint Charlie border crossing with border museum in Kreuzberg. The East Side Gallery, an artistpainted section of the Wall, begins at Ostbahnhof. Before continuing, make a detour to the Soviet Memorial in Treptower Park. You cycle through Treptow's allotment gardens to the former Sonnenallee crossing (made famous by L. Hausmann's film adaptation). You reach Schönefeld and continue cycling past Bukow, between the town and fields to Teltow. Overnight stay in Teltow or the surrounding area.

Day 4: Teltow – Potsdam: app. 30 km

You cycle along the route of the former Stammbahn, Prussia's first railway. Further along the route you will pass the former Dreilinden checkpoint and reach Babelsberg and Potsdam via the Königsweg through the Berlin Forest. Use the afternoon to visit Sanssouci Palace (on your own). Overnight stay in Potsdam.



Day 5: Potsdam – Oranienburg: app. 76 km

Cycle through the landscape of hills, parks and lakes designed by Lenné and Schinkel. Pass the Glienicke Bridge and then take the ferry (on your own) across the Havel to Kladow. You follow the former border through the Groß Glienicker Heide to Staaken. From Staaken your route leads through Spandauer Forst to Nieder Neuendorf. Overnight stay in Oranienburg.


Day 6: Departure from Oranienburg:

For comfortable driving, our rental bikes are usually equipped with a suspension fork and sprung seat posts (subject to availability). This suspension creates a pleasant driving experience, even on a bumpy road. For partner tours (PT) and original partner tours (OPT), the rental bikes may deviate from our description. E-Bike

versions:

- 28 inch women's bikes (not suitable for children under the age of 15)
- 7 or 8-speed hub gear with freewheel or coaster (depending on availability)

Equipment:

- hydraulic brakeemsen
- Parking light automatic
- suspension seat post
- Battery 500 620 Wh, 36 V,
- 13,4 17 Ah (up to 80 km range)
- Klickfix system on the handlebars



Driving offers assistance up to 25 km / h (license free). The battery is conveniently charged using the charger.

Note: The permissible total weight for our electric bikes is 130 kg. The minimum size is 150 cm.
