

Netherlands – Amsterdam in One Hotel Bicycle Tour (2025) Individual Self-Guided 5 days / 4 nights OR 4 days / 3 nights



This is a holiday based at a cyclist friendly hotel in Amsterdam. You will have full days at your disposal for cycling. We have devised routes for you to choose from, so you can decide for yourself where you would like to go: the fishing village of Volendam and cheese town Edam; the world-famous windmills at Zaanse Schans; Muiderslot Castle; or the elegant city of Haarlem. When planning your journey to Amsterdam, do try to arrive early and depart late in the day so you can make the most of the days. This could also be the ideal holiday for those groups with conflicting priorities, like when the some prefer a long cycling trip whereas some have their hearts set on Van Gogh. Meet up again in the evening over a bowl of stamppot to discuss your day.



Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: Arrival Amsterdam

If you arrive early, you could explore the different neighbourhoods of Amsterdam by public transport or on foot. There are fun shopping streets, museums, squares to while away your time, restaurants... enough to fill your day.



Day 2: Round trip Volendam 78 km

Choose one of our four routes. For example the route to Marken, Volendam and Edam on the coast of what used to be Zuiderzee sea. The former two are old fishing villages; the latter shipped out salty, round, polder cheeses to the rest of the world. The 76 km route takes you through picture postcard scenery. Or choose a shorter loop and cycle to the elegant city of Haarlem and back in 46 kilometers.

Day 3: Round trip Muiden 63 km

Choose another of our four routes. The route to Muiden Castle is 63 km long. We have a bit of a military theme going here. The town of

Naarden is a good example of a star shaped fortification (have a peek on google maps!). It's very well preserved, complete with walls and a moat. Next up is the village of Muiden, at the mouth of the River Vecht. Although very picturesque in itself, it is best known for its small moated castle built around 1280 - well worth a visit!

Day 4: Round trip Zaandam 45 km

The last of our four routes takes you to Zaandijk and back in 45 fascinating kilometers. The area around the River Zaan was very early to industrialize thanks to wind power. Hundreds of sawmills, for example, contributed in a big way to the building of the enormous shipping fleet that brought Amsterdam prosperity. This is a fantastic route for those interested in industrial heritage! In addition to quaint old factories and warehouses lining the river, look forward to the beautiful windmills at Zaanse Schans that continue to produce mustard, paint and oil to this day. As the sun sets, back in Amsterdam, you could go for a leisurely stroll through the romantic canal district.

Day 5: Return Home

After breakfast, it's time to pack your bags. There are big lockers at the train station where you can leave your luggage to continue your explorations for another couple of hours, perhaps.

4 day/3 night option:

Day 1: Arrival Amsterdam

Day 2: Roundtrip Volendam (76 km) or Haarlem (47 km)

Day 3: Roundtrip Muiden (63 km) or Zaandam (47 km)

Day 4: Return Home

Technical Characteristics:

Route Profile: Easy. This is an easy cycling trip on relatively flat terrain, suitable for people with little or no cycling experience. Daily cycling distances span roughly 30-50 km.

Distance: 4 day tour: 94- 139 km 5 day tour: 186 km

Travel Season: Departures daily from April 1 until September 23

Please note: a minimum stay of 2 nights in a row is required in the hotel in Amsterdam on the following dates (and a higher price will be charged): April 18, 19,20; April 25,26; *May 29, 30,31; June 6, 7,8; June 21,22; June 24,25; August 29, 30,31

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Bikes

You will receive your rental bike at the start of your holiday and return it before you go home. All bikes are provided with chain locks.

Hybrid Bike

Our hybrid bikes have 24-gears with hand brakes. The hybrid bikes are circa 16,5 kilo.



E-Bike

The e-bikes have a small electric engine and battery, which can be charged at the hotels. You still have to pedal: it just makes pedaling much easier. Some experience with e-bikes is recommended, as the bikes accelerate faster and are heavier than regular bikes because of the electric engine. The weight of the e-bike is ca. 25 kilo. The range on a full battery is +/- 100 KM. We recommend a minimum height of 160 cm for the e-bike.
