


Slovenia - The Emerald Route Bike Tour (2025)

Self-Guided Tour

8 days / 7 nights



Our classic bike tour takes you through Slovenia's most famous historical attractions and the best that Mother Nature has to offer. From the cultural capital through the undulating landscape of the limestone karst, riddled with caves and dotted with castles and churches, to the sparking Adriatic Sea, there is something for everyone.

Cycling tour highlights:

- Visit the famous sights of the capital, Ljubljana
- Experience immense limestone caves
- Take a walk on the Italian side in Trieste
- > Sip typical Teran wine in a world of limestone



Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: ARRIVAL TO LJUBLJANA.

Your journey begins in the Slovenian capital of Ljubljana. After settling into your hotel, take a stroll through the old town center with its beautiful bourgeois houses from the late 19th century, take a funicular ride to the city castle, or relax in a café by the Ljubljanica River that winds through the city.

Day 2: LJUBLJANA - VRHNIKA (\leftrightarrow 41 km, \uparrow 150 m, \downarrow 160 m).

A nice easy first day across the historic and richly diverse plains surrounding the capital. As the morning sun begins to rise high in the sky, you will be cycling across an immense 160-square kilometer marshy plain. The Ljubljansko Barje was once a great lake until it dried up 6000 years ago, leaving behind an incredibly diverse landscape that is now home to some of Europe's rarest forms of bird, plant and insect life. Along the way you can see the remnants of the world's highest railway viaduct in



Borovnica. In hot summer months you can even freshen up in a typical Carst Lake of Podpec. Just before arriving in Vrhnika, you can visit the Technical Museum of the Republic of Slovenia housed in Bistra Castle, where you'll find a great hunting collection and an interesting exhibition of president Tito's cars. (Accommodation in 3* hotel.)



Day 3: VRHNIKA – POSTOJNA (↔ 43 km; 44 km with a side trip to nature reserve Rakov Škocjan, ↑ 760 m, ↓ 510 m)

On this day the roads will take you away from the main tourist routes and off the beaten track. You can also take a short detour to the impenetrable fortress of Predjama castle, wedged tight into a crevasse halfway up a 123-meter cliff-face protruding dramatically into the surrounding basin. Here lived a vivacious and daring knight. Erasmus kept a whole army at bay by utilizing the secret of

the Predjama Caves to sneak out for supplies, which included freshly picked cherries which he used to throw at his adversaries to taunt them. Take the tour and learn how Erasmus met his untimely demise in less than poetic circumstances, as he was literally caught with his pants down. (Accommodation in 4* hotel.)



Day 4: POSTOJNA – ŠTANJEL AREA (\leftrightarrow 32 km; 48 km with a side trip to Predjama Castle, \uparrow 240 m, \downarrow 630 m)

So far nearly 30 million tourists have visited this stunningly beautiful underground Postojna cave formation, carved deep into the heart of the limestone hills. This is the most extensive cave system in Slovenia, covering a total of 21 kilometers. The 1½ hour tour will take you through a fairy tale world full of large and colorful stalactites and stalagmites, not forgetting the unique "human fish", a mysterious creature that lives in dark pools inside the caves. In the afternoon you head to first vineyards of Vipava region. (Accommodation in 3* guesthouse.)

Day 5: ŠTANJEL AREA – LIPICA – DIVAČA (\leftrightarrow 50 km, \uparrow 630 m, \downarrow 360 m)

First stop is perhaps at the botanical garden in Sežana, then it's on to the stud farm of Lipica, where you can visit these beautiful thoroughbred Lipizaner horses whose glistening white coats and gentle, graceful dancing have earned them a worldwide reputation. The history of the Lipica horses is closely linked to the Vienna riding school. Take a tour in a traditional carriage, watch them perform and visit them close up in their stables. This will be a day to remember. If you



have the time for a couple of side-trips, you can also visit the very unusual but also very interesting "War Museum" set in the village tower of Lokev. (Accommodation in 3* hotel.)

Day 6: DIVAČA – MUGGIA (\leftrightarrow 39 km, \uparrow 350 m, \downarrow 780 m)

If you missed Postojna Caves, don't worry – this morning, you have the chance to explore the Škocjan Caves, a UNESCO-listed natural monument known for their stunning beauty and tranquility. Next, head to Socerb Castle, where you'll be treated to breathtaking views of the Bay of Trieste, the Friulian Plain, and even the Julian Alps. Your day trip concludes in the charming town of Muggia, just south of Trieste.





After a day of cycling, unwind with a delicious gelato in the town's historic center or relax on one of its inviting beaches. If you arrive early, consider a quick bus or boat trip into Trieste, a vibrant Italian city renowned for its rich history, cosmopolitan vibe, and captivating atmosphere. (Accommodation in 4* hotel.)

Day 7: MUGGIA – PIRAN (\leftrightarrow 35 km; 46 km with a side trip, \uparrow 230 m, \downarrow 240 m)

Cycling along the coastal road on new cycling path following former railway line. Enjoy great vistas of Slovene coast and Trieste Bay. A coffee stop in fashionable resort of Portorož is a must. The trip ends in the gorgeous Venetian little harbor village of Piran. (Accommodation in 4* hotel.)

Day 8: DEPARTURE.

After breakfast or extension of your stay.

Technical Characteristics:

Total length: 239 km Surface: 75% regional country roads, 15% cycleways, 5% main road (city approach sections). Surface: 95% asphalt and paved, 5% unpaved Difficulty: 2/4. Medium - For those who, for example complete daily trip to the market by bike in nice weather and consider cycling should be fun but not training. Gentle hills or stretches on gravel paths do not cause any difficulties. Average daily elevation gains between 100 and 500 meters
