

Spain – Catalonia along Cycle Lanes Bike Tour (2025)
Individual Self-Guided
7 days / 6 nights



The main theme of this tour is the railway line now used as a cycle track for recreation "the Carrilet". It will take you from the beautiful volcanic region of la Garrotxa to the Mediterranean Sea. The entire tour takes place in the Catalonian region of Girona in the very north eastern tip of Spain. All hotels have swimming pools and you finish with two nights by the beach on a lovely part of the Costa Brava.



Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: Individual arrival to Olot

Your tour begins in the interesting town of Olot, the capital of the Garrotxa Natural Park. Why not visit one of its interesting museums or enjoy a guided tour of the modernist quarter?



Day 2: Round Trip Olot 18 - 26 km + 480 m

Your first cycle will take you exploring this beautiful area on the foothills of the Pyrenees. There are many extinct volcanoes to be seen around Olot, now camouflaged amongst dense woodland. One can still guess where they are by the conical shape of the hills and the flat tops of the edge of the craters. Don't miss the curious chapel hidden in the centre of the crater of Santa Margarida.

Day 3: Olot to Les Planes d'Hostoles 26 km + 170 m

Today you will cycle from Olot to Amer along the "Carrilet". The journey takes you through several towns typical of the area along beautiful landscapes. If you are in the mood for a dip in the afternoon, the 'Gorga Margarida' waterfall is a short walk away. It's worth exploring!

Day 4: Les Planes d'Hostoles to Girona 35 km + 187 m

Today the Carrilet takes you from La Celera de Ter to the Capital of the Province: Girona, a fabulous city which basks in colour and sunshine. Enjoy losing yourself in the old quarter and soak up the atmosphere of this vibrant city!

Day 5: Girona to Sant Feliu de Guixols 42 km + 296 m

Today you will be able to enjoy the white sands and crystal clear waters of the Sant Feliu beaches, which await you at the end of today's route. There will be several interesting towns to stop in before you reach the stunning Costa Brava of Girona.

Day 6: Round Trip Sant Feliu 17 - 24 km + 191 m

Today you will have several great options to choose from, all of which give you the opportunity to explore and enjoy the spectacular beaches and indulge in a refreshing dip or two.

Day 7: Departure

A private transfer can be booked back to Girona or Barcelona or you can extend your stay by the sea!
