

Sweden - Denmark - Stockholm to Copenhagen Bicycle Tour (2025)
Individual Self-Guided
8 days / 7 nights



This exciting cycling holiday is awaiting you with a lot, Northern Europe has to offer: Explore both capital cities Stockholm and Copenhagen, as well as car metropolis Gothenburg and follow the Kattegatt route along Sweden's picturesque West Coast. Most of the times water is accompanying you and of course there is a lot to explore - UNESCO world cultural heritage palace Drottningholm, great nature reserves, culinary highlights as well as Copenhagen, Nordic noble and bike city par excellence.



Itinerary Day to Day

Day 1: Arrival to Stockholm

Take your first stroll through Sweden's capital and explore some of the many sights and tourist attractions. Visit the Royal Palace in old town of Gamla Stan or one of the numerous museums, as the Vasamuseum or Skansen, oldest open air museum in the world.

Day 2: UNESCO World cultural heritage Drottningholm palace ca. 50 km

Along Lake Mälar, Sweden's third largest lake you cycle to UNESCO world cultural heritage Drottningholm Palace. Here, on the shore of the lake, the royal family grew up. Take your time to explore the beautiful palace as well as the Chinese Pavilion dating from the 18th century. You continue your tour across bridges on to the island of Södermalm. You also pass the old town of Stockholm, Gamla Stan with its cobblestone alleys and inviting coffee shops and the island of Skeppsholmen with an impressive modern art sculpture garden. Overnight in Stockholm.

Day 3: Södertälje - Göteborg by train

By train (incl. your luggage) you continue to Gothenburg. In the afternoon there is enough time to explore Gothenburg by foot. Discover Sweden's second largest city from the water during a boat tour, visit the harbor with its walk-in historic ships, the Maritiman museum is also worth seeing. Enjoy a cinnamon bun in the popular Hage district and stroll along the boulevard Kungsportsavenyn. Garden lovers visit the park Trädgårdsföreningen, art lovers the Gothenburg Art Museum.

Day 4: Gothenburg - Kungsbacka 40 - 65 km

While cycling out of town you pass Särö, the former playground of the ancient royal family and Gothenburg high society. Cliffs, lush forests, bays and marinas line your path. In the late afternoon you reach Kungsbacka, a cozy small town with impressive old city.

Day 5: Kungsbacka - Varberg 60 - 75 km

Enjoy the breathtaking views on today's route along of horse farms and fields. Once you reach Åsa the sea is accompanying you again and leading you to Varberg.





Day 6: Varberg - Falkenberg - Helsingborg 40 km

Look forward to picturesque fishing villages and handicrafts. In Träslövsläge you can feast on freshly cooked lobsters and stroll through the older parts of the city. You continue to Falkenberg, one of the oldest cities in the area. Afterwards you go by train within 90 minutes to Helsingborg where you stay overnight.



Day 7: Helsingborg - Helsingør - Copenhagen 55 km

After breakfast the ferry (not included) brings you in just 20 minutes to Helsingør and you have reached Danish territory. Take your time to stroll through the picturesque harbour city and visit Kronoberg Castle before you continue along beautiful sandy beaches, wonderful landscapes and magnificent smelling forests to Copenhagen, the pulsating capital city of Denmark and bike city par excellence.

Day 8: Individual departure or extension

After breakfast your tour ends in Copenhagen. We are happy to extend your holidays with extra nights.

Technical Characteristics:

Route Profile: Relatively easy. You cycle on well sign-posted bike paths and gravel roads as well as side roads with less traffic, short sections are on roads with more traffic. To some extent there are simpler trail conditions with raw gravel. Flat to slightly hilly tour course.

Distance: 285 km

Season 2: June 8 – June 21 and August 24 – September 6
