

Denmark- Danish Baltic Sea Coast by Bike (2024)

8 Days / 7 Nights

Individual Self-Guided



Along the Baltic Sea coast, you can cycle from Rostock to Copenhagen, Denmark. Beach, sea air and sea scent are your constant companion. Discover the coasts of the Danish islands of Falster, Malaga and Zealand, as well as the capital Copenhagen.



Day by Day

Day 1: Arrival in Rostock

directed by the house. Rostock is an ideal starting point for your cycling trip through the Danish island world of Falster, Malaga and Zealand to Copenhagen. Overnight in Rostock or Warnemünde

Day 2: Rostock - Nykabing/Falster, approx. 42 km

During the morning you cycle to the seaport rostock in your own direction. With the Scandlines ferry (incl.) you transfer to Gedser on Falster. Your crossing takes about 2 hours. Then you cycle via Marielyst to Nykabing. On the way to Nykabing, artisans, small galleries or small museums invite you to linger. Overnight in Nykabing.



Day 3: Nykabing/Falster - N'stved, approx. 76 km

Along the Guldborgsund they cycle up to the island of Zeeland. Naestved is one of the oldest cities in the country. Take a detour to Gavna Castle. You can experience history, art and nature on Gavna. The castle park is home to more than 1/2 million bulbs, a rose garden and some rare types of plants and trees. Bonbon Land and a glassworks are located in the neastved area. Overnight in nastved or surroundings.

Day 4: Naestved - Sorø or Ringsted, approx. 63 km

Today your journey continues northwest through the Great Belt countryside. Beautiful beaches and dune landscapes characterize the picture around the holiday and fishing village of Karrebæksminde. You can experience wonderful atmospheres with bathing life, campsites, restaurants and cafés here. The Fisheries and Town Museum takes you through the history of the place. The journey then continues inland to your next stop inland. Overnight stay in Sorø or Ringsted



Day 5: Soro/Ringsted-Roskilde, approx. 43-63 km

Today you cycle to the coasts and fjords at Roskilde. First to the Iselfjord and then on to the Roskildefjord. Roskilde Cathedral is the burial place of many Danish kings. In the footsteps of the Vikings, you can row and sail across the fjord from the harbor in replicas of the old Viking ships. Overnight in Roskilde or the surrounding area.



Day 6: Roskilde - Copenhagen, approx. 44 km

Your last stage will take you back to the Danish capital on a short journey. You may want to reminisce about your Baltic Sea coast discovery tour in a cosy café in Copenhagen in the afternoon with Wienerbröd and a cup of coffee. Or you can visit The Tivoli. Delivery of rental bikes in the afternoon at the hotel. Overnight in Copenhagen.

Day 7: Excursion Copenhagen

Today belongs to Copenhagen and its sights. Discover the Danish capital by bike, which is certainly the number 1 means of transport here and has an excellently developed network of cycle paths. If you don't want to cycle, take a stroll to Nyhavn to see the little mermaid and stroll along the Stroget shopping street or visit the legendary Tivoli amusement park. Overnight stay as the day before in Copenhagen.

Day 8: Departure from Copenhagen

After breakfast return journey in your own direction by Berlin bus from Copenhagen to Berlin or by train from Copenhagen to Nykabing, then by bus to Gedser, then by ferry to Rostock.
